Position Summary: The Pictou Landing First Nation Health Centre is a modern health care facility that provides health care services to the Pictou Landing First Nation community (approximate population: 580). Among the current health care providers are a visiting physician, community health nurse, addictions worker, community health representative and a mental health therapist.

The nurse practitioner will report to the manager of Primary Health Care and will collaborate with the Director of the Pictou Landing First Nation Health Centre on day-to day functions as a member of the Pictou Landing First Nation Health Centre care team. The nurse practitioner will provide culturally safe primary care services at the individual, family, and the community level emphasizing a holistic approach to health promotion, chronic disease management and illness prevention.

Qualifications:

- Minimum successful completion of BScN in Nursing.
- Successful completion of an approved Nurse Practitioner education program leading to a certificate or its equivalent.
- Current registration (or eligibility) as a Primary Health Care Nurse Practitioner in the province of Nova Scotia required.
- Nursing experience working with First Nations peoples.
- Minimum of two years experience as a Primary Health Care Nurse Practitioner.
- Demonstrated competence in electronic communication, excellence in Microsoft Office products, including word, and Electronic Medical Records required.

- Knowledge of Aboriginal rural community and services
- Awareness and respect of Mi'kmaq culture and traditional healing practices
